Cass Park Day Camp and Stewart Park Day Camp have similar missions, although they work with different age groups. Cass Park Camp serves children ages 5-8 and Stewart Park Day Camp serves children 8-14. Both programs strive to provide a safe, fun, cooperative environment for all campers and staff, with experiences that: allow them to grow, foster individuality, and create a sense of belonging for all involved.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: Support staff are assigned to work 1-1 with campers with (primarily developmental) disabilities. Support staff will assist the counselors and the campers in a variety of camp activities that may include swimming, arts and crafts, drama, tennis, nature, boating and archery.

Although part of the camp team, Support staff are hired through the Recreation Support Services program and supervised by year-round staff from that program.

Work Schedule:

July 6th to August 20th, 2021 Camp days are Monday through Friday and there are full-time (35-40 hours per week) and part-time (20 hours per week) positions available. Camp staff training will be held before camp begins.
